MISS CORN FESTIVAL RULES

1. Entry fee for each contestant will be \$30. Entry fee must be paid BEFORE day of pageant. (Checks should be made out to "Morganfield Lions Club")
 2. All contestants will be required to attend practice before day of pageant.
 3. Floor length gowns for all 13 and older. If you have questions or are unsure you can always text a photo of gown to (270) 871-3192 Kathleen Robinson (Director) The styling of 17 and up for Miss and older are the contestant's choice, but still floor length gown for evening gown competition.
 4. Miss division will have a "Corn Festival" wear in addition to an evening gown. It should be casual yet appropriate. Again, if you have questions, you can always text a picture to
 5. Girls may have an on-stage question, if this is the case you will be notified ahead of time and given a list of the SAMPLE questions to practice.
 6. Parents or family/ friends are NOT allowed backstage once the contestants' belongings are dropped off.
 7. Contestants must be ages 17-21 AS OF PAGEANT DAY. All will compete as of their age at the state pageant, even if having a birthday before state or nationals.
 8. Each division winner will go on to represent the Corn Festival at the Kentucky State Festivals pageant in November. It will be held in Lexington, KY. If the winner of her division group chooses not to attend, the next runner up may go in her place as Miss Corn Festival. (The Director will help/consult winners before the state pageant and attend the state pageant to support our winners.)
 9. Last but not least - SPORTSMANSHIP. If there is poor sportsmanship by a contestant, parent or family member of a contestant, not only do you set a bad example, but the contestant could be relinquished of title and all prizes going with that title. This includes behavior in the dressing area, outside the facility, inside the facility, or backstage. If you have any further questions/concerns, please feel free to contact me at any time.
- Practice will be held at The Renaissance Center in downtown Morganfield Wednesday September 24th @5:00 PM. If you cannot attend please contact me to let me know, DAY OF PAGEANT The pageant will start at 7:00 PM on the 25th. Please arrive NO LATER than 6:30. If you are running late, please contact the director to let her know. Otherwise, any contestant not present at 6:30 will be considered a "no show". There will be a dressing area in the Eagles club directly behind the stage. The dressing room will be open at 4:00 on Thursday for contestants. You are welcome to use it to get ready. However, as before mentioned parents and family/friends will NOT be allowed after 5:30.
